Minutes of the Annual Meeting, June 18, 2022

The Iowa Society of Mayflower Descendants met on the 18th of June at the Machine Shed in Urbandale, Iowa.

Governor Linda Cassmann-Randall called the meeting to order at 11:08 a.m.

Captain Tom Jacobson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Elder Ken Callison gave the invocation.

Ken Callison introduced the special guest, Governor General Jane E. Groves Riddell Hurt.

Introduction of Members and Guests

Self- introductions were made by members and guests.

Ken Callison presented a photograph taken with Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds as she presented 4 Iowa Society members an official proclamation of November 2021 as the 400th Anniversary of the First Thanksgiving in Plymouth MA.

Secretary's Report The minutes of the November 2021 meeting were accepted as printed in the newsletter. Treasurer's Report Gerald Graves gave the Treasurer's Report. It is attached to the minutes. He reported that under our new bylaws which drop members who don't pay their dues by December 31, 24 members were dropped but 15 were reinstated upon payment of dues and the reinstatement fee. He reminded members that national dues increased to \$35 and that the Iowa Society has been phasing in the increase by waiving Iowa dues (\$10) in 2021 and then charging \$5 in 2022 for Iowa dues. For 2023, we will finally get back to full Iowa dues of \$10 plus \$35 for national dues (total of \$45).

<u>Historian's Report Gerald Graves gave the Historian's Report.</u> There are 6 new members in 2022 with a total membership of 336.


NOVEMBER MEETING!!
